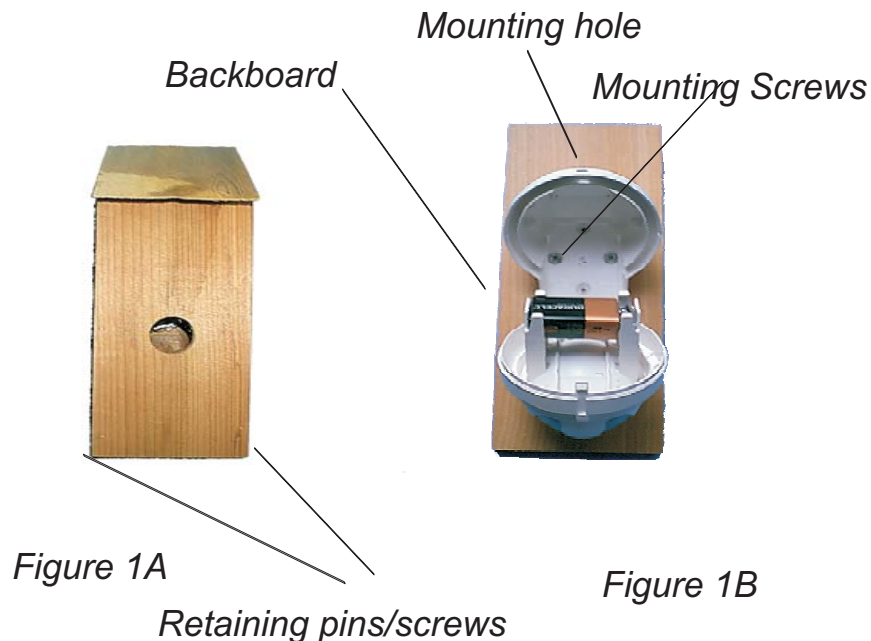

- 1) Find appropriate location for house. The best locations are as close to the driveway as possible and no more than three feet off the ground. It may be mounted to a post, tree, pillar etc.
- 2) Remove the two pins/screws from sides of house to disassemble.
- 3) Mount the backboard to the post or tree using the supplied screws and fitting them through the two mounting holes.
- 4) Mount the Optex sensor to backboard using the supplied screws and the pre-drilled holes as a guide. (see the Optex TD-10 instructions for more information on mounting)
- 5) Adjust sensor's angle of view so sensor will be "looking" in the appropriate direction (see Optex TD-10 instructions)
- 6) Fit the house body onto the back board by fitting over and then sliding down.
- 7) Replace pins to secure body to backboard.
