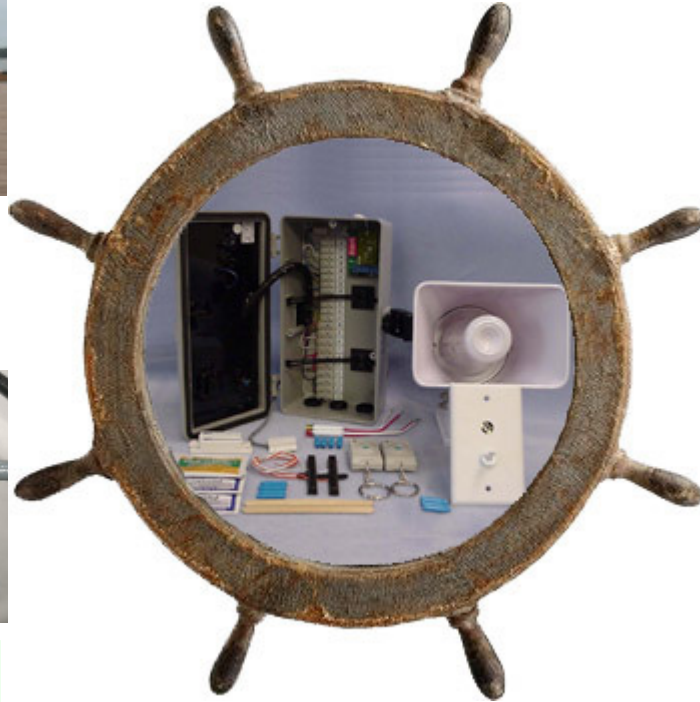

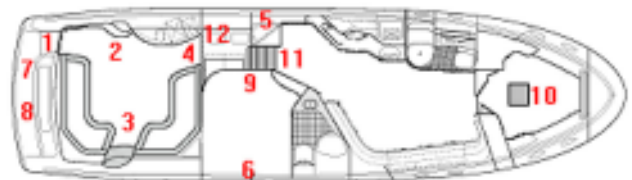


Deck sensors work under any type of decking - no matter how stiff. They catch intruders before damage can happen. Remember - the best protection is prevention.

When designing a system, it is extremely important to determine where an intruder can enter the boat. Usual points of entry include hatches, ladders, open decking, and gun walls. Once the points of entry are chosen, an installer needs to select the equipment that will best cover those points of entry. It is not necessary to provide security protection for every inch of the boat, just the places where an intruder may enter the vessel. Usually, the Deck Sensors are not difficult to install. The most challenging part of the installation is typically running wire.
